Tuition Policy for New Full-time First-year Students**

The policy governing tuition for the cohort of full time undergraduates who entered as new first year students in September 2007 is now in effect. This policy statement follows below. Students who believe they are eligible and want to avail themselves of the provisions of this policy are encouraged to speak with their freshman adviser.

Tuition Policy for New Full-time First-year Students

Policy

A sub-group of the full-time first-year Fall 2007 cohort (the sub-group) will be permitted to register *once* for as many courses as necessary during regular semesters, mini-sessions and summer session during their first year in order to prepare themselves to start their second year as prescribed in the standard second year of their major. Tuition and fees will be limited to two regular semesters of full-time undergraduate tuition and corresponding fees.

The sub-group is defined as the full-time first-year students who are **required** to take extra courses in mathematics or English or who are placed on reduced load **by the University for academic reasons. This includes:**

1. Any General Studies student who is limited to 12 credits in the Fall semester
2. Any HEOP student who is limited to 12 credits in the Fall semester
3. Any Conditional student who is limited to 12 credits in the Fall semester
4. Any student who is required to take MA914 or MA902/912 in the Fall semester
5. Any student who is required to take EN1080 or EN1090 in the Fall semester

Limitations

This policy is limited as follows:

1. The policy applies **only to the sub-group** of students as defined above. Students may not unilaterally opt to go on reduced load for reasons of convenience or other non-academic reasons and benefit from this policy.
2. Students may register for a course **only once** under this policy, i.e., courses in which the student received an F, W or INC grade will be considered courses registered for once. The student will not be able to register for two courses in summer because of a failure. If the student was required to take an extra course in English, that student is entitled to **one** English class in the summer under the policy no matter what grades may have been obtained during the Fall and Spring semesters. (e.g., Fall: MA914 F/ Spring: 914P/ Summer – student is allowed to take Calc 1 only)
3. This policy does not apply to **transfer** students.

4. This policy does not apply to **new students** admitted in the **Spring 2008** semester.
5. Students cannot take courses **not prescribed as first year courses** in their major during regular semesters and then take prescribed first-year courses during a mini or summer session without additional tuition.
6. This tuition policy does not apply to courses taken beginning with the Fall semester of the sub-group's second year, i.e., this policy applies only to a student's first year at Polytechnic. Specifically, prescribed first year courses taken during the second year of study are not covered by this policy, i.e., the standard tuition policy of the University applies.
7. Students who are not members of the Fall 2007 sub-group who wish to re-take a course passed in 2007-8 during Summer 2008 **in order to obtain a better grade** cannot repeat this course without additional cost.

Implementation

1. At the end of each semester, the Academic Advisement Center, in conjunction with the Registrar's office will prepare the list of students eligible to participate in this program and communicate this list to departmental advisers, Student Accounts and Financial Aid.
2. Prior to the end of the Fall semester a list of when all first year courses will be offered will be distributed to advisers.
3. Eligible students enrolled in adviser-approved first year courses will be exempt from tuition charges beyond two semesters of tuition and fees.
4. Students will not be eligible for financial aid for courses for which they are not paying tuition.
5. Not all first-year courses in all majors are guaranteed to be offered in Summer 2008.

SUMMER TUITION FOR UNDERGRADUATE COURSES 2008

\$100/credit:

The Provost will approve a set of courses that will be offered in the summer at \$100/credit. (approved courses: [CE3144](#), [CE2124](#))

- This is a pilot that will be reviewed every year.
- The \$100/credit courses may be offered only once during the regular academic semesters.
- Faculty teaching the courses will receive adjunct pay only.
- The courses must be a prerequisite or core courses in a discipline.

\$ 0/credit

- See 32 credit policy
- Honors Program - Students may take courses that are being offered at no charge as long as they have never taken the class before. Repeats will be handled based on other sections of this policy.

\$476 /credit

- Students not eligible for 32 credit policy may take these courses at a discount rate of \$476/credit as long as there is space available in the class. (A waitlist will be maintained by the registrar. All students who are not eligible for the 32 credit policy will be wait listed in order received regardless of tuition rate to be paid).

\$951/credit

- All other courses.

Fees

\$0/credit – no fee.

All other arrangements - fee paid based on number of credits:

Less than six credits: \$197

6 – 11 credits: \$341

12+: \$539
