# Immunization Guide

*Required Immunizations:*  
You Can't Register Without Them.

## NYS Public Health Law 2165 requires postsecondary students to show proof of immunity against measles, mumps and rubella.

### **WHO must be Immunized?**

- **ALL** Undergraduate and graduate students
- Students born on or after January 1, 1957

### **WHAT constitutes immunity?**

You must have valid proof of immunity for each disease. Valid proof is:

- A. **For MEASLES:**
- Two (2) doses of live measles vaccine given on or after the first birthday, and after 1/1/68, and at least 30 days apart.
- OR**
- Physician— documented history of the disease, including onset date or the disease.
  - Serological (blood test) evident of immunity.
- B. **For MUMPS:**
- One (1) dose of live mumps vaccine given on or after the first birthday, and after 1/1/69.
- OR**
- Physician— documented history of the disease, including onset date or the disease.
  - Serological (blood test) evident of immunity.
- C. **For RUBELLA:**
- One (1) dose of live rubella vaccine given on or after the first birthday, and after 1/1/69.
- OR**
- Serological (blood test) evident of immunity.
  - **Physician diagnosis is NOT acceptable for rubella.**

Measles, mumps and rubella vaccine (MMR) is recommended for all measles vaccine doses to provide increased protection against all three diseases.

### **WHERE can I get Immunized?**

- At your personal physician's office.
- At the local health department for your home or campus.

### **WHAT constitutes acceptable proof?**

- Polytechnic University Student Immunization Record completed by a physician.
- Official immunization record (signed by a physician).
- Doctor's note (on letterhead, signed by a physician).
- High school or previous college official health form.

### **WHAT if I don't provide proof?**

**Immunization status will be checked as part of the registration process. Students who are not in compliance with the law:**

- Will be barred attending class *Students de-registered due to Immunization non-compliance will not be entitled to any tuition refund).*
- Will not receive grades.
- Will be denied further registration.

### **WHEN do I have to submit proof?**

- Students must provide proof prior to registration. In no case will a student be allowed to complete registration without submitting proof.
- New students may obtain an extension of 30 days from the start of classes to complete the process. **After that period, students will be suspended from classes.**

### **WHERE do I have to submit proof?**

### **Are there EXEMPTIONS?**

Exemptions can be granted **only** for individuals with documented religious objections or medical contraindications to vaccination. However, in the event of an outbreak all students who are not immune, regardless of exemption, will be barred from campus.
