Dear International Student:

At Polytechnic, we are concerned about your health and protection against the high cost of medical care. Each year, more and more of our students are faced with unexpected medical expenses, and often without medical care insurance. In an effort to assure that our students have coverage, Polytechnic University requires that all our international students be enrolled in the school sponsored accident and sickness plan. The cost of this insurance policy will be added to your student tuition account.

Medical cost in the United States are very high and are not paid for the by the Government. The individual must be prepared to pay for their own hospital, doctor, medicines and other medical costs. This insurance policy will pay for most of these costs in case of illness or accident. This policy makes certain that the healthcare coverage for all international students meets the school, state, and federal requirements. The coverage is good worldwide.

The following types of services are covered under the school-sponsored Student Insurance Plan, for sickness and for injuries:

Please visit the website at www.poly.edu/studentinsurance for the policy brochure and to obtain your health insurance cards no later than October 3, 2008. You will be asked to confirm or provide some basic information. Your health insurance card can be immediately printed out when you complete your enrollment on-line.

For students enrolling at Polytechnic for the fall semester, your coverage will begin August 24, 2008. The annual premium of \$565 will be split by semester with \$283 charged in the fall and \$282 charged in the spring. New students in the spring will be charged \$334 on their tuition statement.
